It is a huge honour to report on such excellent results. We are pleased with the grade average of 70.3%. Furthermore, 11 of the 19 NSC subject averages were 70% or more. Impressively, 99.3% of our young ladies achieved above 50% as an aggregate and 16.8% achieved an A aggregate.

- The P denotes **positive emotion** such as experiencing happiness, contentment, pride, serenity, optimism, gratitude and hope. We believe that the Class of 2022 have much about which to be positive and for which to be grateful, and we encourage them to seek out positivity. It was very exciting to see their positivity today as they experienced the joy of seeing the results of hard work.
- The E denotes **engagement** in immersing oneself deeply in activities that use one's strengths to experience, of intense focus, and intrinsic motivation to develop. We commend our achievers of the Class of 2022 on the level of motivation and focus that they demonstrated in their matric year.
- The R denotes **relationships**, and we are acutely aware that positive, secure, and trusting relationships enhanced the schooling experiences of the Class of 2022.
- The M denotes **meaning** in belonging to and serving something with a sense of purpose and belief that it is larger than the self; and it is our belief that the Class of 2022 were fortunate to experience the sisterhood that is Collegiate.
- the A denotes **accomplishment** pursuing success, mastery, competence, and achievement for its own sake. The results attained speak to the achievement of this grade in seeking out mastery.

May the Class of 2022 enjoy a flourishing life in the years to come.
